**HANDLING OF ANIMALS.**

\*\*\*(c)(1) During public exhibition, any animal must be handled so there is minimal risk of harm to the animal and to the public, with sufficient distance and/or barriers between the animal and the general viewing public so as to assure the safety of animals and the public.\*\*\*

This facility allows animals to interact with the public in several ways. Included is the opportunity to be a "trainer for a day", or weekend which includes direct contact with animals, including the large felids. These activities do not meet the standard of "sufficient distance and/or barriers between the animal and the general viewing public". Leashes do not constitute a barrier. Those participating in one day, two day, or photo opportunities are members of the general viewing public. A system must be in place to ensure such activities do not take place.
