#### ATTENDING VETERINARIAN AND ADEQUATE VETERINARY CARE (DEALERS AND EXHIBITORS).

Section 2.40(b)(3) Veterinary care: Each exhibitor shall establish and maintain programs of adequate veterinary care that include the daily observation of all animals to assess their health and well-being; Provided, however, that daily observation of animals may be accomplished by someone other than the attending veterinarian; and provided, further, that a mechanism of direct and frequent communication is required so that timely and accurate information on problems of animal health, behavior, and well-being is conveyed to the attending veterinarian.

The left rear lateral hoof of the zebu is overgrown and needs to be trimmed. Hooves need to be kept trim to prevent discomfort and to help prevent foot rot.

### 3.125 (a) REPEAT

#### FACILITIES, GENERAL.

Section 3.125(a) Structural strength: The facility must be constructed of such material and of such strength as appropriate for the animals involved. The indoor and outdoor housing facilities shall be maintained in good repair to protect the animals from injury and to contain the animals.

Two coyotes escaped from their enclosure on July 14, 2010. The wire mesh fencing was pulled apart and away from the wood post in the back lower left corner of the enclosure. The licensee stated during the inspection that this enclosure is going to be demolished. Animal enclosures need to be constructed and maintained to contain the animals to prevent escapes and injuries.

An exit briefing was conducted with the licensee.
