FACILITIES, GENERAL

(a) Structural strength. The facility must be constructed of such material and of such strength as appropriate for the animals involved. The indoor and outdoor housing facilities shall be structurally sound and shall be maintained in good repair to protect the animals from injury and to contain the animals.

*The sloth enclosure has a wooden resting surface with large nail heads projecting from the surface. These protruding nail heads could cause injury to the animal. The resting surface should be repaired or replaced.

*The two indoor enclosures housing the armadillos and giant anteater have damaged walls. The walls are intended to be solid and areas of drywall are missing in both enclosures. The door frames are also missing drywall and wood and are damaged. To facilitate adequate cleaning and ensure structural integrity the walls and entries to these rooms should be repaired or replaced.
