Shelter from sunlight. When sunlight is likely to cause overheating or discomfort of the animals, sufficient shade by natural or artificial means shall be provided to allow all animals kept outdoors to protect themselves from direct sunlight.

\*\*\*Two juvenile lions are being housed in an enclosure without adequate shade. There is a low three sided shelter, but it is too small to afford any cooling effect if both were to enter it at the same time. For the health, well-being, and comfort of the animals some sort of shade must be provided, so they both have access at the same time. Correct by August 2, 2013.
