In addition there was one medication that was a controlled substance which was not expired but was not properly secured by the attending veterinarian. The controlled substance needs to be returned to the veterinarian for proper storage and the expired medications need to properly disposed of.

WATERING.

The water receptacle for the red-handed tamarins has a pvc pipe that leads to the water source which has a blue sealant at the joints. This sealant was applied sloppily and drips were seen on the cage and along the pipe itself. The animals have access to the this dripped sealant and could possibly ingest the chemical. The animal caretaker stated that the pipe could be redone properly.

FACILITIES, GENERAL.

In the sloth enclosure there is a wood perch which is secured to the wire panel wall with a metal bracket. The bracket has a very sharp edge and the edge protrudes into the enclosure. This could cause the three animals possible injury. The animal caretaker stated that this perch was not used and it could be removed.

In the enclosure for the giant anteaters there is a hole dug in the south east corner by the keeper access area. This hole is deep enough that it has passed the concrete pouring along the fence line and sharp uneven concrete is

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exposed. This area needs to be refilled and kept maintained to prevent possible injury to the animals.
