- (a) Each dealer, exhibitor, intermediate handler, or carrier, shall, during business hours, allow APHIS officials:
 - (1) To enter its place of business;
 - (2) To examine records required to be kept by the Act and the regulations in this part;
 - (3) To make copies of the records:
- (4) To inspect and photograph the facilities, property and animals, as the APHIS officials consider necessary to enforce the provisions of the Act, the regulations and the standards in this subchapter; and
 - (5) To document, by the taking of photographs and other means, conditions and areas of noncompliance

On January 19, 2005 I was unable to gain access to the licensee's facility between 1:00and 1:45. The gate was closed and there was no response to honking the car hom. A near-by licensee attempted to reach (b)(6), (b)(7)c by phone but was unsuccessful. I returned to the facility at 3:00 but there was still no one there and the gate was closed.

The licensee's facility was unable to be inspected for compliance with the Animal Welfare Act regulations and standards and to ensure the health and well-being of the animals.

A responsible person must be available to accompany the inspector of an animal welfare inspection. Correct immediately,
