#### ATTENDING VETERINARIAN AND ADEQUATE VETERINARY CARE (DEALERS AND EXHIBITORS).

Each dealer and exhibitor shall employ an attending veterinarian under formal arrangements. In the case of a part-time attending veterinarian or consultant arrangements, the formal arrangements shall include a written program of veterinary care (PVC) and regularly scheduled visits to the premises of the dealer or exhibitor.

A current PVC was not available at the time of inspection. A PVC verified as current by signature of a licensed veterinarian is needed to assure appropriate care and treatments for all animals on hand. Correct by: 29 November 2010

#### FACILITIES, GENERAL.

Structural strength. The facility must be constructed of such material and of such strength as appropriate for the animals involved. The indoor and outdoor housing facilities shall be structurally sound and shall be maintained in good repair to protect the animals from injury and to contain the animals.

The fence enclosing llama, goats and sheep has become detached at the bottom in several places. By one pole on the back side a hole had been created that could result in escape or injury to the animals. A sharp point was exposed near the ground by the concrete block structure. These items need to be corrected to assure the health, safety and well being of the animals. Correct by: 29 November 2010.

An exit briefing was conducted with the Responsible Official and primate enrichment was discussed.
