HOUSING FACILITIES, GENERAL.

Any surfaces that come in contact with nonhuman primates must: (i) Be free of excessive rust that prevents the required cleaning and sanitization, or that affects the structural strength of the surface;

***Indoor enclosure for 2 mangabeys has many areas of rust. Support beam on bottom left is completely rusted thru. Indoor enclosure for 3 snow macaques is also rusted. Need to replace structurally damaged metal and resurface rusted metal to ensure all surfaces can be adequately cleaned and sanitized. Correct by October 15, 2008.

FACILITIES, GENERAL.

Structural strength. The facility must be constructed of such material and of such strength as appropriate for the animals involved. The indoor and outdoor housing facilities shall be structurally sound and shall be maintained in good repair to protect the animals from injury and to contain the animals.

***Barrier fence in several areas (by main entry gate, by Tarzan/Bagheera leopard, by Willie lion) is loose. Need to tighten fence and make sure fence is securely attached to support posts. Correct by September 18, 2008.
