Sec. 3.125 Facilities, general.

- (a) Structural strength. The facility must be constructed of such material and of such strength as appropriate for the animals involved. The indoor and outdoor housing facilities shall be structurally sound and shall be maintained in good repair to protect the animals from injury and to contain the animals.
- ****Multiple enclosures (Tiger, lion, hyenas, bear, etc.) had exposed underground wire which may be dangerous to the animals if their paws and/or limb get caught and entangle in the exposed wire.
- **** Housing facilities shall be structurally sound and shall be maintained in good repair to protect the animals from injury and to contain the animals.

- (c) Drainage. A suitable method shall be provided to rapidly eliminate excess water.
- ****The hyena enclosure had some areas of water accumulation which may result in bacterial overgrowth and the animals getting sick if they drink this water.
- ****The method of drainage shall comply with applicable Federal, State, and local laws and regulations relating to pollution control or the protection of the environment.
