No dealer or exhibitor shall knowingly obtain any dog, cat, or other animal from any person who is required to be licensed but who does not hold a current, valid, and unsuspended license.

Ten exotic animals were found by records to have been obtained by the facility from persons not licensed under the act. Transfer of exotic animal ownership requires a USDA license. Correct for future procurements

SANITATION.

Housekeeping. Premises (buildings and grounds) shall be kept clean and in good repair in order to protect the animals from injury and to facilitate the prescribed husbandry practices set forth in this subpart. Accumulations of trash shall be placed in designated areas and cleared as necessary to protect the health of the animals.

Building supplies and other items not required for animal husbandry were stored on top of the Coatamundi enclosure. These items need to be removed to protect the animals and prevent harborage of pests. Correct By: 23 December 2011
