HANDLING OF ANIMALS.

The regulations state, "All licensees who maintain wild or exotic animals must demonstrate adequate experience and knowledge of the species they maintain."

***In July 2010, a helper walked by the bear enclosure while holding feed scoops that had just been used to feed the wolves in an adjacent enclosure. One of the bears was able to stick her head through the feeding slot in her enclosure (an approximately 10" by 10" opening) and bit the helper on the side of the breast. The helper called the Licensee (who was at an exhibition) to inform him of the incident, then drove herself to the hospital.

All employees, assistants, helpers and volunteers must be adequately trained and supervised to ensure their personal safety as well as the safety of the animals.
