3.125 (a)
FACILITIES, GENERAL.

a) Structural strength. The indoor and outdoor housing facilities shall be...maintained in good repair to protect the animals from injury

The paint is peeling off of the wire mesh panels used as enclosures for the various animals in the petting zoo. The peeling paint may be ingested by the animals which may sicken or injure the animals. The panels must be repaired and maintained to protect the health and safety of the animals.
Correct by November 30, 2011.

3.125 (c)
FACILITIES, GENERAL.

(c) Storage. Supplies of food and bedding shall be stored in facilities which adequately protect such supplies against deterioration, molding, or contamination by vermin.

When the owner opened the back of the trailer used to transport the animals, there were open bags of feed, which is cluttered and dirty. There is soiled bedding on the floor which had not been cleaned out after transport to the current location. There is a medication dispenser, plastic bags, hardware and an empty feed bag. The licensee rolled down the tops of the bags during the inspection. Open bags of feed may become contaminated by soiled bedding, debris, dirt and vermin. Consuming contaminated food may sicken or injure the animals. Food shall be stored in a manner that protects it from deterioration and contamination.
Correct by November 5, 2011.

The owner stated that there were no other regulated animals, and no vehicles nor animal hauling trailers other than the one that was inspected.
