### **3.125** (a) **REPEAT**

#### **FACILITIES, GENERAL.**

(a) Structural strength. The facility must be constructed of such material and of such strength as appropriate for the animals involved. The indoor and outdoor housing facilities shall be structurally sound and shall be maintained in good repair to protect the animals from injury and to contain the animals.

The wooden top of the resting surface for the three lions is splintered on the interior corner. This needs to be repaired or replaced to protect the animals from injury.

### **3.131** (a) **REPEAT**

#### **SANITATION.**

(a) Cleaning of enclosures. Excreta shall be removed from primary enclosures as often as necessary to prevent contamination of the animals contained therein and to minimize disease hazards and to reduce odors.

There were many ash-colored feces on the floor and on top of the den of the bobcats enclosure. This demonstrates that the enclosure is not being cleaned as often as necessary to prevent contamination and to minimize disease hazards and reduce odors. The enclosure needs to be cleaned and the waste properly disposed of.

This was a focused inspection of the noncompliances identified on the last inspection.

The direct noncompliance identified on the previous inspection [3.75 (a) Housing Facilities, General] concerning the death of the black and white lemur due to the possible attack by a coyote, appears to have been corrected by the licensee. The licensee has been keeping a new dog in the area for protection.

An exit briefing was conducted with the licensee.
