ATTENDING VETERINARIAN AND ADEQUATE VETERINARY CARE (DEALERS AND EXHIBITORS).

Section 2.40(b)(2) Each exhibitor shall establish and maintain programs of adequate veterinary care that include the use of appropriate methods to prevent, control, diagnose, and treat diseases and injuries, and the availability of emergency, weekend, and holiday care.

Six of the seven fallow deer have small patches of hair loss on their bodies and necks. The deer have received no treatment for this condition. Animals must receive adequate veterinary care to maintain their health and well-being. These animals must receive appropriate care as directed by the attending veterinarian.
Correct by August 8, 2012.

2.40 (b) (3)

ATTENDING VETERINARIAN AND ADEQUATE VETERINARY CARE (DEALERS AND EXHIBITORS).

Section 2.40(b)(3) Each exhibitor shall establish and maintain programs of adequate veterinary care that include daily observation of all animals to assess their health and well-being; Provided, however, That daily observation of animals may be accomplished by someone other than the attending veterinarian; and Provided, further, That a mechanism of direct and frequent communication is required so that timely and accurate information on problems of animal health, behavior, and well-being is conveyed to the attending veterinarian.

Six of the seven fallow deer have small scattered patches of hair loss on their bodies and necks. The attending veterinarian has not been informed of this condition. The attending veterinarian must receive timely information on animal health problems to ensure animals receive appropriate care.

FACILITIES, OUTDOOR.

Section 3.127(c) Drainage. A suitable method shall be provided to rapidly eliminate excess water.

1) The enclosure housing the zebu has standing water and mud in front of both entrances to the shelter. Animals should not have to walk through water and mud to gain access to shelter. The drainage by the shelter entrances must be improved to maintain the health and comfort of the animal.
Correct by August 8, 2012.

2) The enclosure housing 4 alpacas has standing water and mud around the water container. Animals should not have to walk through water and mud to gain access to their water. The drainage by the water container must be improved to maintain the health and comfort of the animals.
Correct by August 2, 2012.
