Section 2.40(b)(3) Veterinary care: Each exhibitor shall establish and maintain programs of adequate veterinary care that include the daily observation of all animals to assess their health and well-being with a mechanism of direct and frequent communications with the attending veterinarian so that timely and accurate information on problems of animal health, behavior and well-being is conveyed to the attending veterinarian.

The goat named Latoya has hair loss and flaky skin on her body with the right side being worse. Latoya was observed rubbing her body against enclosure surfaces. The goat has not been seen by the attending veterinarian and is not on treatment. The facility had no documentation regarding the condition. The goat needs to be brought to the attention of the attending veterinarian so she can receive the appropriate veterinary care.

The animals need to be observed daily to access their health with a mechanism for communicating information on animal problems to the attending veterinarian in a timely manner so animals can receive the appropriate veterinary care.
