#### HOUSING FACILITIES, GENERAL.

Substances that are toxic to the nonhuman primates but that are required for normal husbandry practices must not be stored in food storage and preparation areas, but may be stored in cabinets in the animal areas.

There were several toxic substances in the animal areas and the feed storage area.

All of the items were removed during the inspection.

### 3.125

#### FACILITIES, GENERAL.

(a) Structural strength. The facility must be constructed of such material and of such strength as appropriate for the animals involved. The indoor and outdoor housing facilities shall be structurally sound and shall be maintained in good repair to protect the animals from injury and to contain the animals.

In the kangaroo enclosure there were two sprinklers, a damaged ground level light and a sewage cap that were accessible to the animals. The wood post entry gate was not latched securely for this enclosure. The door would not properly secure to the outside post.

The metal slats for the two tamanduas housed indoors were too far apart and allowed the animals feet to pass through. This was corrected during the inspection by moving the animals to another enclosure.

These items were repaired during this inspection.

An exit briefing was conducted with the licensee.
