The interior of the roof, doors and sides in the back cargo area are lined with wood that is damaged, splintered and missing pieces. Housing facilities should be structurally sound and kept in good repair to ensure animal containment, protect the animals from injury and to meet husbandry and housekeeping requirements as directed by the Animal Welfare Act. The wood should be repaired or replaced.
