(d) Perimeter fence. The fence must be constructed so that it protects the animals in the facility by restricting animals and unauthorized persons from going through it or under it and having contact with the animals in the facility, and so that it can function as a secondary containment system for the animals in the facility.

The chain link facility perimeter fence is directly adjacent to alligator infested waters and land. Several alligators were seen outside the fence during this inspection. A large hole has washed away on both sides and under the fence behind the bobcat enclosure. The size of the opening is sufficiently big enough for alligators to gain entrance to the animal area. An area behind the shed is washed away on the outer side of the fence and an opening will soon be present in this location also. The permiter fence must be adequately constructed to prevent unwanted animals from going under it and it must function as an appropriate secondary containment system for the animals in the facility. For the protection of the public and animals the fence and adjacent area should be repaired or replaced.
