SANITATION.

Premises (buildings and grounds) shall be kept clean and in good repair in order to protect the animals from injury and to facilitate the prescribed husbandry practices set forth in this subpart. Accumulations of trash shall be placed in designated areas and cleared as necessary to protect the health of the animals.

There was a 6" (approx) piece of plastic coated wire on the ground in the deer enclosure. Previously, one of the deer in this enclosure ingested a plastic bag which was found on necropsy and may have contributed to its death. The facility continues to use plastic bags to put alligator feed into which is then available for sale to the public to feed to the alligators.

The facility management has indicated that they have increased policing and removing of foreign materials from the enclosures so that these items may be quickly removed and not be ingested by the mammals if they should get into the enclosures, but it appears that the current policing & removal of these items is not entirely effective.

The current piece of plastic coated wire if ingested can injure an animal. Animal enclosures shall remain free of hazardous materials and trash which are used at this facility that can injure an animal.

Correct immediately

The exit interview was conducted with the Animal Coordinator and Asst Animal Coordinator/Contact Person.

This is a focused inspection which was limited to the re inspection of all non complaint items identified on the last inspection.
