There is (are) no responsible, knowledgeable and readily identifiable employee(s) or attendant(s) in this general area.

A barrier fence shall be constructed at least 3 feet from the enclosure to prevent the public from having contact with the animals. Alternatively, you may station a responsible, knowledgeable and readily identified employee or attendant in this area at all times when the public is present.
