FACILITIES, GENERAL.

Some of the lower horizontal metal poles in the bear den have advanced deteriorating rust and are no longer structurally sound. These poles serve as the lower attachment of the enclosure chain link.

The chain link roof in panther enclosure # 2 (from left side) also has advanced deteriorating rust and may not be structurally sound. Additionally, some of the U nails in the panther enclosures are also rusty. These nails also attach the hog panels to the wood frames of the enclosures.

Inspect all metal surfaces & fasteners and remove or replace deteriorating rust so that all enclosures are structurally sound and capable of containing the animals.

WATERING.

The bear's drinking water currently consists of a large man made concrete pool. This water in this pool has a milkygreen color.

All water receptacles shall be kept clean and sanitary at all times. Consider utilizing another smaller water receptacle which may be easier to maintain clean.

SANITATION.

Rodent dropping were observed on the food prep area floor and floor in back area behind the stage.

A safe and effective pest control program shall be implemented & maintained in these areas to reduced the pests. A better cleaning of these areas may facilitate the eradication of rodents.
