ATTENDING VETERINARIAN AND ADEQUATE VETERINARY CARE (DEALERS AND EXHIBITORS).

- At the time of the focused inspection there was a female fennec fox with multiple lesions that appeared to be scratches and bite wounds on her ears, left hip and shoulder. This fennec fox is also thin compared to her enclosure mates. The licensee stated he had heard yips and yells from this enclosure but had not observed them fighting. Untreated wounds from bites and scratches cause pain and discomfort and can become infected. This animal must be examined by a licensed veterinarian and appropriate treatment administered.
