3.81 Environment enhancement to promote psychological well-being.

Dealers, exhibitors, and research facilities must develop, document, and follow an appropriate plan for environment enhancement adequate to promote the psychological well-being of nonhuman primates. The plan must be in accordance with the currently accepted professional standards as cited in appropriate professional journals or reference guides, and as directed by the attending veterinarian. This plan must be made available to APHIS upon request.

The owner has two primates a black capped capuchin and a ring tailed lemur. A written primate enrichment program was not available at the time of the inspection. It is important for the health and well being of primates to make sure enrichment enhancement is adequate to promote psychological well-being. Need to have a complete enrichment program available for inspections.
