At the time of inspection, there was no written program of veterinary care available for review. Each dealer and exhibitor shall employ an attending veterinarian under formal arrangements. In the case of a part-time attending veterinarian, the formal arrangements shall include a written program of veterinary care. A completed written program of veterinary care is important for the care of the animals and ensures clear and accurate communication between the facility and the attending vet. The licensee must have a completed program of veterinary care available for review during inspections. To be corrected by August 11, 2022.

Records: Dealers and exhibitors.

During the review of paperwork and records it was noted that the acquisition records were incomplete. All of the required information for whom the animals were purchased from or otherwise acquired was unavailable at the time of inspection. Appropriate documentation of acquired regulated animals is essential for proper identification, tracing forward and trace back of the animals. The licensee must correctly document records of acquisition for all regulated animals, including animals born on the premises, and assure that all records are kept as required.
