The facility did not have complete disposition records. Required information for disposition records were missing for one African serval, two ring-tailed lemurs, two Patagonia caviés, two kinkajous, one raccoon, three armadillos, one goat, and twenty-six rabbits.

Facilities, outdoor.

The newly-added drive-through park is not enclosed by a perimeter fence. Upon expansion at the facility, the drive-through park now utilizes its perimeter fencing as its primary enclosure fencing for the animals housed in this area of the

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park.

Having a perimeter fence in place protects the animals in the facility by restricting animals and unauthorized persons from going through it or under it, permitting contact with the animals in the facility. Additionally, it serves as a secondary containment system for the animals in the facility.

The perimeter fence must be of sufficient distance from the outside of the primary enclosure to prevent physical contact between animals inside the enclosure and animals or persons outside the perimeter fence. Non-dangerous animals housed in outdoor facilities require a 6-foot-tall perimeter fence around their enclosure and must be at least 3-feet away from any enclosures or buildings.

This is a 1st Re-License Inspection for a Class "C" license. The inspection and exit briefing were conducted with the applicant.

All items must be in compliance within 2 more inspections or by March 10th, 2023, or the applicant will forfeit the license fee and must wait 6 months to reapply. Please contact your inspector to schedule your next Re-License Inspection.

Regulated activity can continue under your existing USDA license until it expires.
