ORDER AUTHORIZING THE RETENTION OF FIREARMS

The Court, having considered the State's Motion for Seizure and Retention of Firearms made pursuant to I.C. 35-47-14 et seq., and having heard and considered the evidence and arguments presented by the parties on May 3, 2021 and September 14, 2021, does hereby grant said Motion and finds as follows:

- 1) A hearing was held and testimony heard on May 3, 2021, and the court made a good faith effort to hold said hearing within 14 days of the filing of the above referenced Motion. Judge Lisa Glickfield of the Clark Circuit Court #3 heard the matter. The Respondent, Timothy Stark, was present and represented by counsel David Mosley. The Court took the matter under advisement pending further arguments by both parties on September 14, 2021. The respondent was present pro se and gave argument to the court on his own behalf on September 14, 2021.
- 2) The State has presented clear and convincing evidence to find that Timothy Stark is a dangerous person as defined by I.C. 35-47-14-1(a)(2)(B).
- 3) The firearm seized by Police Officers of the Clark County Sheriff's Department and owned by Timothy Stark is identified as a rifle bearing serial number SE000728.

It is therefore ORDERED that:

- 1) The firearm identified as a rifle bearing serial number SE000728 that is in the custody of the Clark County Sheriff's Department shall be retained pursuant to I.C. 35-47-14-6(b). The firearm shall not be disposed of until further order of this Court.
- 2) Any license to carry a handgun received by Timothy Stark is hereby suspended pursuant to I.C. 35-47-14-6(b), and Timothy Stark is hereby enjoined and prohibited from renting, receiving transfer of, owning or possessing a firearm.
